What if I want to work on Saturday?

A request must be phoned in to AFNS no later than 3:00 p.m. on Friday. The AFNS System is not available on Sunday.

REPORTS

AFNS emailed monthly reports should always be saved and stored off of the email system for future audit purposes.

What is AFNS?

Advantage Financial Standard is an accounting system purchased by the State of Alabama to be utilized at the agency level of accounting by the participating agency. It was formerly known as LGFS until this newer version of the system was installed. There are 15 unique applications within AFNS, utilized by State Agencies to manage their financial data. The financial data at the agency level must crosswalk to the statewide level known as CAS.
